## Introductory

# Notice of proposal

- 2 (1) The [F5]lead enforcement authority] shall give to the person affected a notice informing him of the proposal and of the [F6]lead enforcement authority's] reason for it; but paragraph 1(2) above shall not apply for the purposes of this sub-paragraph.

and where notice is given under paragraph (b) above the [F8]lead enforcement authority] shall arrange for the oral representations to be heard.
