PART I

ORDERS AND DECISIONS UNDER SECTIONS 3, 4 AND 6

Decision

- 6 (1) The [FIOFT] shall take into account in deciding whether to proceed with [F2its] proposal any written or oral representations made in accordance with the preceding provisions of this Schedule.
 - (2) If the [F1OFT] considers that [F2it] should proceed with [F2its] proposal but for a reason which differs, or on grounds which differ, from those set out in the notice of the proposal under paragraph 2 above, [F2it] shall give a further notice under that paragraph.
 - (3) In any case where—
 - (a) a notice under paragraph 2 above gives more than one reason for the proposal or (in the case of a proposal to make an order under section 3 of this Act) sets out more than one matter which the [FIOFT] intends should be specified as the grounds for the order, and
 - (b) it appears to the [FIOFT] that one or more of those reasons should be abandoned or, as the case may be, that one or more of those matters should not be so specified,

the [F1OFT] may nevertheless decide to proceed with [F2its] proposal on the basis of any other reason given in the notice or, as the case may be, on any other grounds set out in the notice.
