Miscellaneous and supplemental

14 Interpretation.

(1) In this Act-

"the Act of 1977" means the ^{M1}Aircraft and Shipbuilding Industries Act 1977;

"appointed day" means such day as the Secretary of State may appoint by order made by statutory instrument after consulting British Aerospace and the Treasury;

"share" includes stock;

[^{F1}"subsidiary" has the meaning given by section 1159 of the Companies Act 2006;]

"the successor company" has the meaning given by section 1(1) of this Act; and

"wholly owned subsidiary" has [^{F2}the meaning given by [^{F3}section 1159 of the Companies Act 2006]].
