



Import of Live Fish (England and Wales) Act 1980

1980 CHAPTER 27

4 Interpretation.

In this Act—

“eggs” include milt;

“fish” includes shellfish;

“freshwater fish” means any fish living in fresh water including eels and the fry of eels, but excluding salmon;

“Minister” means

(a) in relation to England, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food;
and

(b) in relation to Wales, the Secretary of State for Wales;

“salmon” includes all migratory fish of the species *Salmo salar* and *Salmo trutta* commonly known as salmon and sea trout respectively;

“shellfish” includes crustaceans and molluscs of any kind and any spat or spawn of shellfish.

Changes to legislation:
