

Import of Live Fish (England and Wales) Act 1980

1980 CHAPTER 27

4 Interpretation.

In this Act—

- "eggs" include milt;
- "fish" includes shellfish;
- "freshwater fish" means any fish living in fresh water including eels and the fry of eels, but excluding salmon;
 - "Minister" means
- (a) in relation to England, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food;
- (b) in relation to Wales, the Secretary of State for Wales;
- "salmon" includes all migratory fish of the species Salmo salar and Salmo trutta commonly known as salmon and sea trout respectively;
- "shellfish" includes crustaceans and molluscs of any kind and any spat or spawn of shellfish.
