PART V

NOTARIES PUBLIC

Offence for notaries public to act for unqualified persons

- (1) Any notary public who upon the account or for the profit of any unqualified person—
 - (a) draws or prepares any writ to which section 32 applies; or
 - (b) permits or suffers his name to be made use of in the drawing or preparing of any such writ; or
 - (c) does any other act to enable that person to appear, act or practise in any respect as a solicitor or notary public,

knowing such person not to be a qualified solicitor or notary public, as the case may be, shall be guilty of an offence.

(2) In this section "person" includes a body corporate.
