PART III

GENERAL

32 Orders and regulations.

- (1) Any power conferred by any provision of this Act to make an order or regulations shall be exercisable by statutory instrument.
- (2) ^{F1}..., any statutory instrument made under any power conferred by this Act shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of the House of Commons.
- [^{F2}(3) But in the case of an order under section 26H(4) which has the effect of adding to the class of activities in respect of which remote gaming duty is chargeable—
 - (a) subsection (2) above shall not apply, and
 - (b) the order may not be made unless a draft has been laid before and approved by resolution of the House of Commons.]
