- Any person who sustains damage by being disturbed in the use of land or water by reason of the coming into operation of the order (not being damage which consists of the diminution in the value of an interest in land) shall be entitled to recover compensation for the damage—
 - (a) from the Secretary of State, if the order is made in respect of an aerodrome vested in or under the control of the Secretary of State; and
 - (b) from the CAA, if it is made in respect of an aerodrome owned or managed by the CAA.
