[11F ^{F1} Remedies for breach of contract.

- (1) Where in a [^{F2}relevant contract for the transfer of goods] a transferor is in breach of any term of the contract (express or implied), the other party to the contract (in this section referred to as “the transferee”) shall be entitled—
- (a) to claim damages; and
 - (b) if the breach is material, to reject any goods delivered under the contract and treat it as repudiated.
