#### [11F <sup>F1</sup> Remedies for breach of contract. **S**

- (1) Where in a [<sup>F2</sup>relevant contract for the transfer of goods] a transferor is in breach of any term of the contract (express or implied), the other party to the contract (in this section referred to as “the transferee”) shall be entitled—
- to claim damages; and
  - if the breach is material, to reject any goods delivered under the contract and treat it as repudiated.
