#### 75 General interpretation.

In this Act—

“the <sup>M1</sup>1967 Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967;

“the <sup>M2</sup>1972 Act” means the Road Traffic Act 1972;

“prescribed” means prescribed by regulations made by the Secretary of State; and

“road” means any highway and any other road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes [<sup>F1</sup>except that in Scotland it has the same meaning as in the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984].
