### PART I

DAMAGES FOR PERSONAL INJURIES ETC.

#### Claims not surviving death

## <sup>X1</sup>4 Exclusion of Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1934.

- The following subsection shall be inserted after section 1(1) of the <sup>M1</sup>Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1934 (actions to survive death)—
  - "(1A) The right of a person to claim under section 1A of the Fatal Accidents Act 1976 (bereavement) shall not survive for the benefit of his estate on his death.".
- (2) The following paragraph shall be substituted for subsection (2)(a)—
  - "(a) shall not include—
    - (i) any exemplary damages;
    - (ii) any damages for loss of income in respect of any period after that person's death;".
