Functions of the Secretary of State

122 Provision of pocket money for in-patients in hospital.

- (1) [F1Welsh Ministers may (in relation to Wales)] pay to persons who are receiving treatment as in-patients (whether liable to be detained or not) in [F2 special hospitals or other hospitals, being hospitals] wholly or mainly used for the treatment of persons suffering from mental disorder, such amounts as [F3 the Welsh Ministers think fit] in respect of [F4 those persons'] occasional personal expenses where it appears to [F5 the Welsh Ministers] that [F6 those persons] would otherwise be without resources to meet those expenses.
- (2) For the purposes of ^{F7}... [^{F8}the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006], the making of payments under this section to persons for whom hospital services are provided under [^{F9}that Act] shall be treated as included among those services.
