Miscellaneous provisions

140 Notification of hospitals having arrangements for reception of urgent cases.

It shall be the duty of [F1 every Primary Care Trust and of] every [F2 Health Authority] to give notice to every local social services authority for an area wholly or partly comprised within the [F3 area of the Primary Care Trust or Health Authority] specifying the hospital or hospitals administered by [F4 or otherwise available [F5 Primary Care Trust or][F2 to the Health Authority]] in which arrangements are from time to time in force for the reception, in case of special urgency, of patients requiring treatment for mental disorder.
