1983 CHAPTER 3

8 Interpretation

In this Act—

" agriculture and horticulture " includes everything included in the expression " agriculture " as defined by section 109(3) of the Agriculture Act 1947 or, as the case may be, section 86(3) of the Agriculture (Scotland) Act 1948 and " agricultural and horticultural " shall be construed accordingly;

" animal " includes any bird or fish ;

" the Central Council " means the Central Council for Agricultural and Horticultural Co-operation ;

" fish " includes crustaceans and molluscs of any kind ;

" fish products " means any food made wholly or partly from fish processed otherwise than solely by filleting or gutting;

" food " includes any food or drink produced or processed for human or animal consumption (including game of any kind) and any ingredient of such food or drink ;

" the Ministers " means the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland, the Secretary of State for Wales and the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland acting jointly ;

" pension " includes a superannuation allowance or gratuity payable to or in respect of any person on retirement or death;

" processed " means having been subjected to any kind of process including packaging or bottling ;

" sea fish " means any fish (excluding crustaceans and molluscs of any kind) found in the sea except any of the salmon species, trout and eels ; and

" transferred functions " means functions transferred to Food from Britain by section 2(1) above.
