1983 CHAPTER 35

10 Interpretation. E+W+S

(1) In this Act—

"joint body" means a joint body constituted solely of two or more such councils as are mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (f) of the definition of "litter authority" below;

"litter authority", in relation to England and Wales, means, except so far as is otherwise provided—

- (a) a county council,
- (b) a district council,
- (c) a London borough council,
- (d) the Common Council of the City of London,
- (e) a parish council,
- (f) a community council,
- (g) a joint body,

 - (i) the Sub-Treasurer of the Inner Temple, or
 - (j) the Under Treasurer of the Middle Temple;

- [^{F4}(2) In the application of this Act in relation to Wales, any reference to a county shall be read as including a reference to a county borough and any reference to a county council shall be read as including a reference to a county borough council.]
