#### CHARGES FOR LOCAL AUTHORITY SERVICES

## 17 Charges for local authority services in England and Wales.

- (1) Subject to subsection (3) below, an authority [<sup>F1</sup>in England] providing a service to which this section applies may recover such charge (if any) for it as they consider reasonable.
- (2) This section applies to services provided under the following enactments—

- [<sup>F5</sup>(2A) Subject to subsection (3) below, an authority in Wales providing a service under section 2 of the Carers and Disabled Children Act 2000 in the form of residential care may recover such charge (if any) for it as they consider reasonable.]
  - (3) If a person—
    - (a) avails himself of a service to which this section applies [<sup>F6</sup>or a service within subsection (2A)], and
    - (b) satisfies the authority providing the service that his means are insufficient for it to be reasonably practicable for him to pay for the service the amount which he would otherwise be obliged to pay for it,

the authority shall not require him to pay more for it than it appears to them that it is reasonably practicable for him to pay.

- (4) Any charge under this section may, without prejudice to any other method of recovery, be recovered summarily as a civil debt.
- [<sup>F7</sup>(5) [<sup>F8</sup>Subsection (2A), and subsections (3) and (4) so far as they relate to it, have] effect subject to any regulations under section [<sup>F9</sup>15] of the Community Care (Delayed Discharges etc.) Act 2003 (power to require certain community care services and services for carers to be free of charge).]
