#### THE BRANCH COUNCILS

- 26 (1) There shall continue to be a branch council for England, for Wales, for Scotland and for Northern Ireland.
  - $[^{F1}(2)$  The branch council for each area shall be constituted as provided by the General Council.
  - (2A) Some or all members of a branch council may be persons who are not members of the General Council.]
    - (3) The General Council may delegate to a branch council such of the functions of the General Council <sup>F2</sup>... as the General Council think fit.
