

Registered Homes Act 1984

1984 CHAPTER 23

An Act to consolidate certain enactments relating to residential care homes and nursing homes and Registered Homes Tribunals, with amendments to give effect to recommendations of the Law Commission. [26th June 1984]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- C3 Act: functions not to be exercised by a primary care trust (1.4.2000) by virtue of S.I. 2000/695, reg. 4(1), Sch. 4
