SPEED LIMITS

83 Provisions as to directions under s. 82(2)

- (1) [^{F1}A direction under section 82(2) by the Secretary of State shall be given] by means of an order made by the Secretary of State after giving public notice of his intention to make an order.
- [^{F2}(2) A direction under section 82(2) by a local traffic authority shall be given by means of an order made by the authority.]
- (3) Section 68(1)(c) of this Act shall apply to any order made under subsection (2) above.
