1984 CHAPTER 56

Foster children for the purposes of the Act

1 Foster children.

Subject to section 2, a child is a foster child for the purposes of this Act if

- ^{F1}(a) below the upper limit of the compulsory school age, and
 - (b) his care is undertaken ^{F2} . . . by a person who is not a relative or guardian of his.
