

Foster Children (Scotland) Act 1984

1984 CHAPTER 56

Foster children for the purposes of the Act

1 Foster children.

Subject to section 2, a child is a foster child for the purposes of this Act if

- [F1(a)] below the upper limit of the compulsory school age, and
- (b) his care is undertaken $^{\rm F2}$. . . by a person who is not a relative or guardian of his. $^{\rm F2}$
