68 Reconsideration of rent after registration.

Where the rent payable for any dwelling-house has been entered in the register under section 67 above then, subject to section 66(4) above, the lessor or the lessee ..., ^{F1} may refer the case to the [^{F2}First-tier Tribunal] for reconsideration of the rent so entered.
