## 23 Meaning of "premises" etc.

In this Act—

"premises" includes any place and, in particular, includes-

- (a) any vehicle, vessel, aircraft or hovercraft;
- (b) any offshore installation;
- (ba) [<sup>F1</sup>any renewable energy installation;]

(c) any tent or movable structure; <sup>F2</sup>...

"offshore installation" has the meaning given to it by section 1 of the <sup>MI</sup>Mineral Workings (Offshore Installations) Act 1971.

[<sup>F3</sup>"renewable energy installation" has the same meaning as in Chapter 2 of Part 2 of the Energy Act 2004.]
