23 Meaning of “premises” etc.

In this Act—

“premises” includes any place and, in particular, includes—

- (a) any vehicle, vessel, aircraft or hovercraft;
- (b) any offshore installation;
- (ba) [^{F1}any renewable energy installation;]
- (c) any tent or movable structure; ^{F2} . . .

“offshore installation” has the meaning given to it by section 1 of the ^{M1}Mineral Workings (Offshore Installations) Act 1971.

[^{F3}“renewable energy installation” has the same meaning as in Chapter 2 of Part 2 of the Energy Act 2004.]
