THE HOUSING CORPORATION

[^{F1}Relevant Authority's] powers with respect to land and works

91 Protection of persons deriving title under transactions requiring consent.

- [^{F1}Where the [^{F2}Housing Corporation] purport to acquire or dispose of land—
- (a) in favour of a person claiming under the [^{F2}Housing Corporation] the transaction is not invalid by reason that any consent of the Secretary of State which is required has not been given, and
 - (b) a person dealing with the [^{F2}Housing Corporation], or with a person claiming under the [^{F2}Housing Corporation], shall not be concerned to see or inquire whether any such consent has been given.]
