THE HOUSING CORPORATION

[FI Relevant Authority's] powers with respect to land and works

91 Protection of persons deriving title under transactions requiring consent.

[F1Where the F2Housing Corporation] purport to acquire or dispose of land—

- (a) in favour of a person claiming under the [F2Housing Corporation]the transaction is not invalid by reason that any consent of the Secretary of State which is required has not been given, and
- (b) a person dealing with the [F2Housing Corporation], or with a person claiming under the [F2Housing Corporation], shall not be concerned to see or inquire whether any such consent has been given.]
