CREDITORS' VOLUNTARY WINDING UP

[^{F1}104A Progress report to company and creditors ^{F2}... [^{F3}(England and Wales)]

- (1) [^{F4}[^{F5}Where the company is registered in England and Wales]] [^{F4}The] the liquidator must—
- (a) for each prescribed period produce a progress report relating to the prescribed matters; and
 - (b) within such period commencing with the end of the period referred to in paragraph (a) as may be prescribed send a copy of the progress report to—
 - (i) the members and creditors [^{F6}, other than opted-out creditors] of the company; and
 - (ii) such other persons as may be prescribed.
- (2) A liquidator who fails to comply with this section is liable to a fine.]
