MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

434 Crown application.

For the avoidance of doubt it is hereby declared that provisions of this Act which derive from the ^{M1}Insolvency Act 1985 bind the Crown so far as affecting or relating to the following matters, namely—

- (a) remedies against, or against the property of, companies or individuals;
- (b) priorities of debts;
- (c) transactions at an undervalue or preferences;
- (d) voluntary arrangements approved under Part I or Part VIII, and
- (e) discharge from bankruptcy.
