Poinding

25 Second pointing in same premises.

Subject to sections 9(12), 23(2), 28(2) and (6), 29(2), 40(5) and 41(6) of this Act, where articles are pointed in any premises (whether or not the pointing is valid), another pointing in those premises to enforce the same debt shall not be competent except in relation to articles which have been brought on to the premises since the execution of the first pointing.
