HOUSES IN MULTIPLE OCCUPATION

Supplementary

177 Statutory tenant to be regarded as lessee, etc.

In this Part—

- (a) references to a lessee of a house and to a person to whom a house is let include references to any person who retains possession of the house by virtue of the ^{M1}Rent (Scotland) Act 1984 [^{F1}or Part II of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1988] and not as being entitled to any tenancy; and
- (b) references to a person having [^{F2}a right] or interest in a house include references to any person who retains possession of the house as mentioned in paragraph (a).
