PROVISION OF HOUSING

[^{F1} Standards and performance in housing management]

[^{F1}19 Admission to housing list

- (1) An applicant for housing held by a [^{F2}social landlord] is entitled to be admitted to a housing list unless the applicant is under 16 years of age.
- (2) In this section, “housing list” means a list of applicants for housing which is kept by any [^{F3}social landlord] or jointly by or on behalf of any two or more [^{F4}social landlords] in connection with the allocation of housing held by it or them for housing purposes.
- [^{F5}(3) In this Part, “social landlord” means any local authority or any registered social landlord.]]
