## 1987 CHAPTER 27

### PART V **E+W+S**

#### MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

##### *Miscellaneous*

**45 Entertainment licences: removal of exemption. **E+W+S****

The Royal Albert Hall shall cease to be exempt from the requirement for a public entertainment licence under paragraph 1 of Schedule 12 to the London Government Act 1963.

**46 Entertainment licences: fees for variation. **E+W****

In Schedule 1 to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 (licensing of certain public entertainments), after paragraph 16, there shall be inserted the following paragraph—

“16A An applicant for the variation of the terms, conditions or restrictions on or subject to which an entertainments licence is held shall pay a reasonable fee determined by the appropriate authority.”

**47 Luminous tube signs: England and Wales. **E+W****

In section 10 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 (luminous tube signs of certain voltage to have firemen’s switches)—

- (a) in subsection (1), for the words “650 volts” there shall be substituted the words “the prescribed voltage”; and

(b) after subsection (1), there shall be inserted the following subsections—

“(1A) In subsection (1) above “the prescribed voltage” means 1000 volts A.C. or 1500 volts D.C. if measured between any two conductors or 600 volts A.C. or 900 volts D.C. if measured between any conductor and earth.

(1B) The Secretary of State may, by order made by statutory instrument, substitute such different voltages for those for the time being specified in subsection (1A) above as appear to him to be appropriate for this purpose having regard to the current regulations of the Institution of Electrical Engineers.”

#### 48 **Luminous tube signs: Scotland.** **S**

In section 98 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (power of Secretary of State to make regulations for safe operation of electrical luminous tube signs) in subsection (2) for the words “normally exceeding 650 volts” there shall be substituted the words “ of such description as may be specified in regulations made under subsection (1) above ”.
