- 2 (1) In section 2 of the Trade Descriptions Act 1968 (meaning of trade description)—
- (a) for paragraph (g) of subsection (4) (marks and descriptions applied in pursuance of the ^{M2}Consumer Safety Act 1978) there shall be substituted the following paragraph—
 - “(g) the Consumer Protection Act 1987;” and
 - (b) in subsection (5)(a) (descriptions prohibited under certain enactments), for the words “or the Consumer Safety Act 1978” there shall be substituted the words “or the Consumer Protection Act 1987”.
- (2) In section 28(5A) of the said Act of 1968 (disclosure of information authorised for purpose specified in section 174(3) of the ^{M3}Consumer Credit Act 1974), for the words from “section 174(3)” onwards there shall be substituted the words “section 38(2)(a), (b) or (c) of the Consumer Protection Act 1987.”
