#### VARIATION OF AREA TREATED AS THE BROADS

#### PART II

##### VARIATION BY ORDER

- 3 Where [<sup>F1</sup> Natural England ] has received a proposal from the Authority that the area which constitutes the Broads (for the purposes of this Act) should be varied, it shall consider the proposal and either reject it or conduct a review under this Schedule.

  - (b) are given an opportunity to make representations on it within such a reasonable period as may be specified by [<sup>F2</sup> Natural England ].

- 10 Before making to [<sup>F6</sup> Natural England ] any proposal of any kind mentioned in paragraph 3 above, the Authority shall consult—
- (a) each of the appointing authorities other than the Secretary of State; and
  - (b) the internal drainage board for any internal drainage district which appears to the Authority to be likely to be affected by the proposal.
