1988 CHAPTER 54

3 Repeals. **U.K.**

- (1) The enactments specified in Part I of Schedule 1 to this Act are repealed to the extent specified in the third column.
- (2) Those repeals include the repeal, in accordance with Recommendations of the Law Commission and the Scottish Law Commission, of section 34 of the ^{M1}Road Traffic Act 1972 (requirements as to employment of persons to attend to locomotives and trailers) as no longer of practical utility.
- (3) The subordinate legislation specified in Part II of that Schedule is revoked to the extent specified in the third column.
