36 Interpretation.

(1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

[F1" approved training establishment" means an establishment approved by the Council under section 12(7)(a) above;

- (b) a national of the United Kingdom who is seeking access to, or is pursuing, the profession by virtue of an enforceable Community right; or
- (c) a person who is not a national of a relevant European State but who is, by virtue of an enforceable Community right, entitled to be treated, for the purposes of access to and pursuit of the profession, no less favourably than a national of a relevant European State;]

- (b) section 42 of the M2National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1947; and
- (c) section 21 of the M3Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948;

"individual registrant" means any person whose name is in a register maintained by the Council under [F9 section 7, 8A or 8B] above;]

"medical authority" means one of the universities and other bodies who choose appointed members of the General Medical Council;

[F10" optometrist" means] a person engaged or proposing to engage in the testing of sight (otherwise than as a registered medical practitioner or a person recognised by a medical authority as a medical student), whether or not he is also engaged or proposing to engage in the fitting and supply of optical appliances;

"optical appliance" means an appliance designed to correct, remedy or relieve a defect of sight;
