



Civil Aviation (Air Navigation Charges) Act 1989

1989 CHAPTER 9

An Act to enable charges imposed under section 73(1)(a) of the Civil Aviation Act 1982 to be prescribed in units of account defined by reference to more than one currency. [25th May 1989]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Charges prescribed in units of account.

After subsection (1) of section 73 of the ^{M1}Civil Aviation Act 1982 (charges for air navigation services) there shall be inserted—

“(1A) Regulations under subsection (1)(a) above may—

- (a) prescribe any charges to which the regulations apply in units of account defined by reference to more than one currency; and
- (b) make provision for any charges prescribed in such units to be paid and recovered either in such units or in their equivalent, as determined in accordance with the regulations, in such currencies as may be prescribed.”
