Accounts and audit

- 6 (1) The Ombudsman shall keep accounts with respect to his receipts and expenditure and shall prepare a statement of accounts with respect to each financial year.
- (2) The accounts shall be kept, and the statement of accounts prepared, in such form as the [^{F1}Secretary of State] may, with the approval of the Treasury, direct.
- (3) The accounts shall be audited by persons appointed by the [^{F1}Secretary of State] in respect of each financial year.
- (4) The auditors shall send to the [^{F1}Secretary of State] a copy of the statement of accounts and of their report.
- (5) The [^{F1}Secretary of State] shall lay before each House of Parliament a copy of every statement of accounts and auditors' report sent to him under this paragraph.
