PART II

PROCEEDINGS OF FLOOD DEFENCE COMMITTEES

Appointment of sub-committees, joint sub-committees etc.

- (1) For the purpose of carrying out any functions in pursuance of arrangements under 11 paragraph 12 below—
 - (a) a flood defence committee may appoint a sub-committee;
 - two or more regional or two or more local flood defence committees may appoint a joint sub-committee of those committees;
 - any sub-committee may appoint one or more committees of that sub-(c) committee ("under sub-committees");
 - (2) The number of members of any sub-committee and their terms of office shall be fixed by the appointing committee or committees or, in the case of an under subcommittee, by the appointing sub-committee.
 - (3) A sub-committee appointed under this paragraph may include persons who are not members of the appointing committee or committees or, in the case of an under subcommittee, the committee or committees of whom they are an under sub-committee; but at least two thirds of the members appointed to any such sub-committee shall be members of that committee or those committees, as the case may be.
 - (4) A person who is disqualified for being a member of a flood defence committee shall be disqualified also for being a member of a sub-committee or under sub-committee appointed under this paragraph.
