##### *General drainage charges*

#### **134 Raising of general drainage charges.**

- (1) Subject to subsection (2) below, the [F1 appropriate agency] may raise at an amount per hectare of chargeable land in [F2 a flood risk management region] a charge to be known as a general drainage charge and to be levied in accordance with sections 135 and 136 below.
- (2) The [F3 Agency] shall not levy a general drainage charge in respect of [F4 any flood risk management region] unless [F5 the Regional Flood and Coastal Committee for that region] have recommended that such a charge should be raised.
