

Access to Neighbouring Land Act 1992

1992 CHAPTER 23

6 Variation of orders and damages for breach.

- (1) Where an access order or an order under this subsection has been made, the court may, on the application of any party to the proceedings in which the order was made or of any other person on whom the order is binding—
 - (a) discharge or vary the order or any of its terms or conditions;
 - (b) suspend any of its terms or conditions; or
 - (c) revive any term or condition suspended under paragraph (b) above; and in the application of subsections (1) and (2) of section 4 above in relation to an access order, any order under this subsection which relates to the access order shall be treated for the purposes of those subsections as included in the access order.
- (2) If any person contravenes or fails to comply with any requirement, term or condition imposed upon him by or under this Act, the court may, without prejudice to any other remedy available, make an order for the payment of damages by him to any other person affected by the contravention or failure who makes an application for relief under this subsection.
