CHILD BENEFIT

[F1142 Presence in Northern Ireland.

- (1) No child benefit shall be payable in respect of a child [F2 or qualifying young person] for a week unless he is in Northern Ireland in that week.
- (2) No person shall be entitled to child benefit for a week unless he is in Northern Ireland in that week.
- (3) Circumstances may be prescribed in which [F3 any] person is to be treated for the purposes of [F4 subsection (1) or (2) above] as being, or as not being, in Northern Ireland.]
