



European Communities (Amendment) Act 1993

1993 CHAPTER 32

6 Committee of the Regions.

A person may be proposed as a member or alternate member for the United Kingdom of the Committee of the Regions constituted under Article 198a of the Treaty establishing the European Community only if, at the time of the proposal, he is [^{F1}a member of the Scottish Parliament][^{F2}a member of the National Assembly for Wales or]an elected member of a local authority.
