Companies Act 1967 (c.81)

- 29 Section 89(1) of the Companies Act 1967 (criminal liability of directors, etc. of an industrial assurance company) shall continue to have effect as amended by the ^{M1}Insurance Companies Act 1974 and the ^{M2}Insurance Companies Act 1982, that is, with the substitution of “director, chief executive or manager (as defined in the Insurance Companies Act 1982)” for the words from “director” to “manager”.
