



# State Hospitals (Scotland) Act 1994

## 1994 CHAPTER 16

### **2 Consequential amendments and repeals**

- (1) In section 105(4)(b) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978 (procedure as respects orders), the words “and 102(2)” are hereby repealed.
- (2) In section 108(1) of that Act (interpretation), for the definition of “state hospital” there shall be substituted the following—

““state hospital” has the meaning indicated in section 102(2);”.
- (3) Sections 90 and 91(1) of the Mental Health (Scotland) Act 1984 are hereby repealed.
- (4) In section 91(2) of that Act (constitution of State Hospital Management Committee), for the words “on his behalf and subject to such directions as he may give” there shall be substituted the words “by virtue of section 102(4)(a) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978”.
- (5) In section 125(1) of that Act (interpretation), in the definition of “State hospital”, for the words “Part VIII of this Act” there shall be substituted the words “section 102(2) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978”.
