### Evidence

### 53 Burden of proof.

Where in any proceedings for an offence under section 29, [<sup>F1</sup>31A,] 34, 37 or 45 any question arises as to—

- (a) the number of vehicles used,
- (b) the character, weight or cylinder capacity of a vehicle,
- (c) the seating capacity of a vehicle, or
- (d) the purpose for which a vehicle has been used,

the burden of proof in respect of the matter lies on the accused.
