Homosexuality

147 Homosexuality on merchant ships and in the armed forces: Northern Ireland.

- (1) In the ^{M1}Homosexual Offences (Northern Ireland) Order 1982, the following are revoked—
- (a) in article 3(1) (homosexual acts in private), the words “and Article 5 (merchant seamen)”; and
 - (b) article 5 (homosexual acts on merchant ships).
- (2) Article 3(4) of the Homosexual Offences (Northern Ireland) Order 1982 (homosexual acts in the armed forces) is revoked.
- (3) Nothing in this section shall prevent a homosexual act (with or without other acts or circumstances) from constituting a ground for ^{F1}... dismissing a member of the crew of a United Kingdom merchant ship from his ship ^{F2}...
