## PART IV

## POLICE POWERS

Powers of police to stop and search

## [<sup>F1</sup>60A Retention and disposal of things seized under section 60.

- (1) Any things seized by a constable under section 60 [<sup>F2</sup>or 60AA] may be retained in accordance with regulations made by the Secretary of State under this section.
- (2) The Secretary of State may make regulations regulating the retention and safe keeping, and the disposal and destruction in prescribed circumstances, of such things.
- (3) Regulations under this section may make different provisions for different classes of things or for different circumstances.
- (4) The power to make regulations under this section shall be exercisable by statutory instrument which shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.]
