Vesting of property, &c. of Crown Agents in a successor company

6 Use of "Crown Agents" as part of company name.

The words "Crown Agents" may, notwithstanding anything in section 26(2)(a) of the ^{MI}Companies Act 1985 (prohibition of name giving impression of connection with Her Majesty's Government), be used as part of the name of—

- (a) the successor company,
- (b) any company of which the successor company is a wholly-owned subsidiary, or,
- (c) any subsidiary of the successor company or any such company; and the power conferred by section 32 of that Act (power to require company to abandon misleading name) shall not apply in relation to the use of those words as part of the name of any such company.
